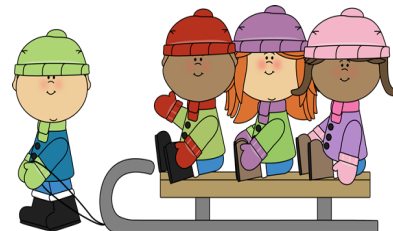
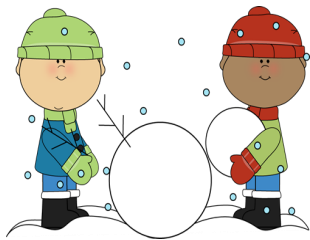

MAKING AN IMPRESSION: CREATING ARTFUL STAMPS

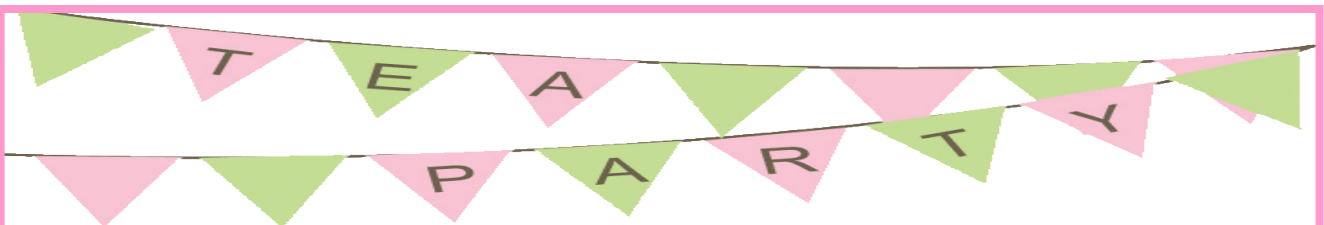
Wednesday February 21st at 11:00 a.m.
